Introduction

Nehru yuva Krida and Sanskrutik Mandal, Chikhli, dist-buldana, was established in the year 1993. The society was established with the aim that it would provide quality education to the students' from the remote places, by running different educational institute's in the form of senior college, junior college, school, technical institute, Pharmacy College and Niwasi School etc. It also arranges competitive and cultures events for the youngsters and promotes them to participate in different extracurricular activities.

The society through its colleges organizes various activities in the form of tree plantation, blood donation camp, youth welfare camp. Through the society Honorable Dr. Nileshji Gawande laid the foundation of Gawande College of Pharmacy in the rural place Sakharkherda. Diploma in Pharmacy was started in the year 2015. B. Pharm. Degree Course has been started from the year 2017-18 and at present institute runs D. Pharm. & B. Pharm. Courses. The courses are started with the aim to provide better opportunities to the students coming from the remote areas. The college has well developed infrastructure, with well developed laboratories, well qualified teaching faculty and supporting staff.

The college has been recognized by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). College is affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.

Section - 02 Available Courses

Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm.) Intake Capacity – 60

Duration - 02 years

Diploma in Pharmacy was started in 2015-16 with the intake capacity of 60 students. The effective teaching has been made more effective by classroom lectures, demonstration, illustrations, lab assignments with audio-visual aids, projects, study/industrial tours, seminars and other activities.

The infrastructure facilities include fully equipped laboratories as per AICTE norms, along with sophisticated equipments, machines computers and softwares. Also, the college has highly qualified and dedicated teaching and non teaching staff and acknowledged in teaching and in industry.

Eligibility for first year D. Pharm.

For admission in first year D. Pharm, the candidate should have passed the H.S.S.C. examination (XII) of Maharashtra State Board of secondary & Higher Secondary Education or any other examination equivalent to the board examination with English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology/Mathematics.

Examination

The course of Diploma in Pharmacy is of 2 years after H. S. S. C. based on yearly pattern. The examination is conducted at the end of each academic year by MSBTE. Internal Sessional examinations are conducted regularly every year and the marks obtained in these Sessional examinations carry 20% weightage in board examination. Students have to secure at least 40% marks in each theory subject. Also 40% marks are required in the Practical to pass the examinations.

Industrial Training

After successful completion of two years course a student is required to undergo practical training of 8 week in medical shop/hospital. After successful completion of course & training the candidate is awarded Diploma in Pharmacy by Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai which is recognized qualification throughout the country.

2. Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.)

Intake Capacity – 100 Duration - 04 years

Bachelor of Pharmacy is started from the session 2017-18 with the intake capacity of 100 students. The course offers jobs, business and entrepreneurial opportunities in the field of manufacturing, selling quality control, research & development of medicines, government jobs in food and drug administration and in hospitals. The demand of the pharmaceutical industry is exceeding than the availability of the professionals. So to meet the demand of the industry the college trains the students with efforts.

The infrastructure facilities include fully equipped laboratories as per AICTE norms, along with sophisticated equipments, machines computers and softwares. Also, the college has highly qualified and dedicated teaching and non teaching staff and acknowledged in teaching and in industry.

Eligibility

First year B. Pharm.

The candidate should have passed the H. S. S. C. (Std. XII) or equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology or Mathematics and should have secured minimum 50% marks (45% for backward class candidates of Maharashtra) in Physics, Chemistry and biology or mathematics added together. The candidate should have appeared and obtained ranking for MHT-CET Examination for pharmacy degree course conducted by the competent authority of govt. of Maharashtra for the current academic year or diploma holders who have passed the diploma course in pharmacy with minimum of 50% marks from the recognized institutes.

Examination

The course of Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.) is of four years, based on semester pattern. The examination is conducted by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati at the end of each semester. The marks obtained in these Sessional carry 25% weightage in university examination. The candidate has to obtain minimum 45% marks in each

theory subject and 50% marks in each practical subject to pass the examination. During the Third or Fourth year of degree of Pharmacy course a student is required to undergo industrial training of eight weeks in a recognized pharmaceutical industry for the award of degree. The candidate is awarded Degree in Pharmacy by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati at the end of successful completion of eight semesters & eight weeks industrial training.

RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- A) Rules, Regulations and Special Instructions for Students:
- The application form for admission should be carefully filled in any duly furnished with all necessary documents like original Leaving certificate / Transfer certificate, Marklist, Other certificates and adequate fees.
- 2) The fees paid at the time of admission will not, in any case, be refunded if the student wants to leave the college immediately after the admission.
- While the classes are being engaged, the students should not in any way disturb them by roaming aimlessly in the corridors or by talking loudly. They should observe complete silence. It the college premises mobile is not allowed.
- No meetings or programmes should be organized in the college campus without the prior Permission of the Principal.
- 5) No original certificates can be claimed back after admission to college.
- 6) If the student, after he has left college, requires a duplicate copy of the leaving certificate, he will have to submit the affidavit with Rs. 50/- as fees for the same.
- Notices will be pasted / panned on the notice Boards and the students themselves should take note of them. Notices will not be circulated in the class-rooms.
- 8) If the student needs information other than given in the prospectus, he should contact the concerned persons in the college office.
- The student will have to carry his identity card with himself during his presence in the college. He should not enter the college campus without identity card. He is not liable to attend any function in the college, if he cannot produce his identity card on demand.
- 10) The student should carry his identity card with himself while entering the college.
- 11) If the student needs leaving certificate or other certificates, he should write application addressed to the Principal. After fulfilling the necessary conditions, he may get the certificates the next day.

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- 12) The student should preserve all receipt of fees paid. They will have to produce these receipts in the office as and when required.
- 13) The student should have 75% attendance in all subjects in order to be able to appear at the Board / University exam. His conduct and progress in Studies should be satisfactory and up to a standard level. If he/she remains absent without prior permission, he/she will be penalized with fine
- 14) The student who remains absent in the periods of tutorials, practical and physical training / education will be fined.
- 15) The student should be cautious about the regularity in attendance. If he is unable to attend the college on medical grounds, he should write an application to that effect the college office, along with the medical certificate.
- 16) The decisions of college regarding extracurricular activities will be final and binding to each student.
- 17) The conduct of the student should be such that he should not cause nuisance to others. The cases of misconduct will be seriously dealt with.
- 18) The students should carefully handle the college books, laboratory equipment, lights, fans etc.
 They should not in any way, cause damage to the college property.
- 19) Eating Gutakha, Chewing tobacco and smoking in college campus is strictly prohibited.

B. General Information and facilities for Students:

1) Library:

The college has a rich and spacious library of its own. The college students can borrow textual as well as non-textual book from the library for the whole session. There is a provision of special reading room for the students, where they can consult reference books or read various science magazines, general magazines, news papers etc. The rules of lending books and other procedures are displayed the notice board of the library. The working hours of the library are from 7:30 am to 5:50 pm. The students should observe silence in the library.

.2) Games and Sports Contests:

The students are always encouraged to participate in various games and sports contests and competitions. The students have facilities to take part in games like Kabaddi, Kho-Kho. Badminton. Volleyball, Cricket etc. The college participates in the various events of games and sports. The talented students are always encouraged. In this regard, the students should contact the Physical education teacher from time to time.

3) Vehicle Stand / Parking:

There is a special vehicle stand for college students to park their vehicles. The students parking their vehicles in no-parking zones will be fined/penalized.

4) Guardian - Student Meet:

Every year guardians and parents of students are invited to college on a certain date. It is a sort of Annual Social Gathering of the guardians and students, in which the guardians freely give suggestions for the betterment of the institution.

5) Information, Guidance and Counseling Cell:

This centre provides the students information regarding higher education, various competitive examinations, personality development etc.

6) Educational Tours:

Educational tours for college students are arranged every year.

7) Extra Curricular Activities:

There will be no annual social gathering in lieu of it, various extracurricular activities are undertaken through various cultural programmes, seminars, games and sports etc. Thus provide opportunities to exhibit their talents.

8) Dress Code/Uniform:

The college has dress code for the staff and students.

9) Daily monitoring in Campus:

College has established a monitoring committee consisting of teachers and non teaching staff to check out Trespassers and to ensure smooth running of the college.

10) Network Resource Centre (NRC):

The College has Network Resource Centre (NRC) with computers and internet facility in the Library and Computer Lab.

11) Botanical Garden:

A small but useful botanical garden is available for the student of botany and others for study, consisting of variety of plants.

12) Girls' Common Room:

Girls' Common Room is present in the campus with basic needs.

13) Student Grievance Redressal Cell:

General Grievance of the Students is solved in this cell. A special cell is established to rectify the complaints of the students.

14) Suggestion Box:

Suggestion box is placed in the college premises near the office. Proper and positive suggestions are invited from the students to improve the status of the college.


